PSHE

Our learning for this half term will focus on families and what they offer us. We will also be thinking about other groups that we may belong to and how they can act like a family providing us with care and support.

Music

Our unit for this half term is - call and response (animals). Children will follow and create musical patterns, represent animals using untuned instruments and develop their understanding of dynamics to help them represent the animals with greater accuracy.



Computing

This half term we will thinking about programming. Will will follow and create algorithms to meet a criteria. Children will practise debugging algorithms to make sure they are working correctly. They will also be learning about staying safe in a digital world.

Geography

We will be learning about the world. We will focus on the continents and oceans that make up the world making links to our science learning about habitats.



RE

PE

P.E. will involve developing our ball skills. We will aim to become more accurate when throwing, rolling and kicking a ball towards a target.



English

We will be basing our learning around the book 'The journey home'. Children will be developing their understanding and use of different types of sentences and using adjectives to describe. We will also be focusing on the basic skills of using capital letters, punctuation accurately and the correct formation of our letters.

Science

Our Science topic for this half term is Living things and their habitats.

Children will consider how we can tell if something is alive or not. They will sort and classify things as either living, nolonger living or never lived. They will then consider the different habitats that can be found on Earth and the different plants and animals that live in these places making links to their learning in Geography.



Maths

In maths this term we will be learning about number and place value.

Children will develop their confidence with counting forwards and backwards within 100 from any number. They will be able to identify the value of each digit in a two-digit number and partition two-digit numbers in different ways.

Children will also count in 2s, 5s, 10s and 3s with growing confidence.
