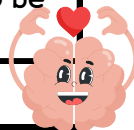


Our value for this half term is: **Co-operation**

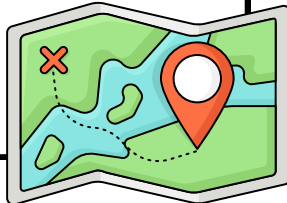
PSHE

In P.S.H.E. our unit of learning is "Health and wellbeing" We will think about the fact that we can feel more than one emotion at a time and that not everyone feels the same things in the same situation. We will consider the effect of physical activity on our bodies and the importance of relaxation. The children will also think about things that they would like to be better at and how they can achieve this.



Art

In Art our unit is called "Map it out". We will be creating artwork that is inspired by maps which will link with our geography learning. Children will be making abstract pieces of art as well as relief maps of their journey to school.

Music

In Music our theme is "Musical Me" which will focus pitch. Children will learn to follow pitch patterns and to read simple notation. They will understand when notes stay the same and when notes are missing on the staff.



Geography

We will be consolidating all of our geographical skills to consider what Windlesham is like to live in. We will use our map reading skills as well as identifying the physical and human features of the village. Children will consider if Windlesham is a good place to live and why as well as what would make it better.

Computing

In Computing we will start by learning about the internet and how to search for things safely and effectively using filters. We will then move on to using the i-pads to make music giving us a chance to combine our computing and musical knowledge to compose our own music digitally.



RE

In R.E. we will be focussing on the question:
Who is Allah and how do Muslims worship him?

We will learn about who Allah is and the importance of prayer and the rituals that surround prayer for Muslims. We will also learn that a Muslim's special place is a mosque and it's features.



PE

We will focus on striking and fielding games. To develop our skills we will work on tracking a rolling ball, underarm throwing and catching for fielding a ball and overarm throwing to limit a batters score. We will also develop our batting skills, trying to increase the distance we can hit a ball and we will make sure we are following rules and playing fairly.



English

Handwriting:

This half term we will finish revisiting the one-armed robot family to continue refining and improving our handwriting. We will then be looking at the zig-zag monster family of letters



Writing:

This half term we will be basing our learning on the book 'A walk in London'. Children will learn to write persuasively, encouraging people to walk more. The unit will culminate in them creating a walking guide for Windlesham allowing them to use their knowledge from their geography learning to support them.

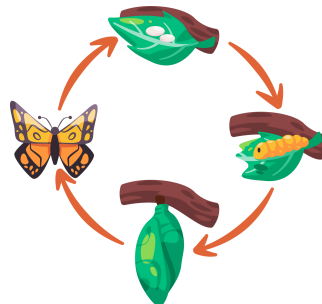

Science

Our Science topic for this half term is "Animals including Humans". We will be building on our learning in Year 1 and thinking different ways that animals can be sorted into groups (amphibians, reptiles, birds, fish, mammals), life-cycles and the ways in which different animals change as they grow, and the basic needs for survival.



Maths

Our next maths topic is: Fractions

We will be making links between fractions. We will learn about the names and roles of the different numbers in a fraction. We will make links with division and the need for "equal groups". Children will learn about the difference between unit and non-unit fractions as well as equivalent fractions.
