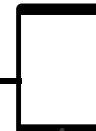

## Computing

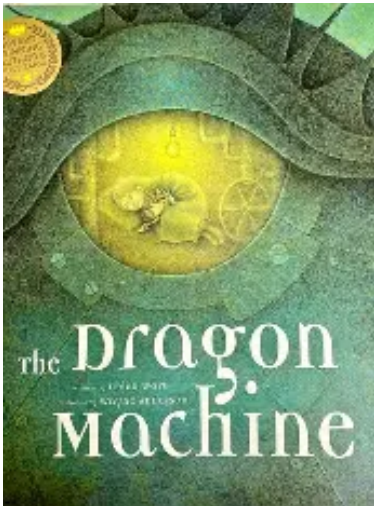
## PE

## Science

Our Science topic for this half term is 'Plants'. The children will conduct a comparative test to see what happens to seeds if they don't have water/light/warmth. They will also learn about germination, the plant life-cycle and what plants need in order to remain healthy.
