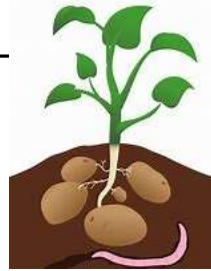
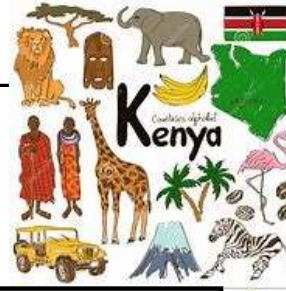

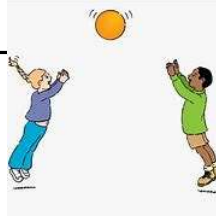
In Geography we will be comparing the UK with Kenya looking at similarities and differences in climate, and human and physical geographical features.



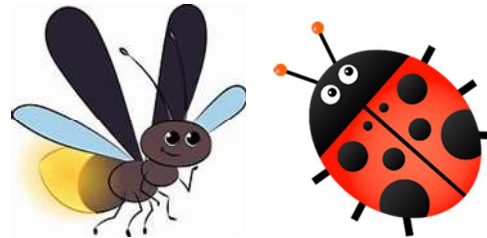
In Art we are learning about how to add texture to drawings by using a range of different mark making techniques such as hatching, scribbling, stippling and blending.



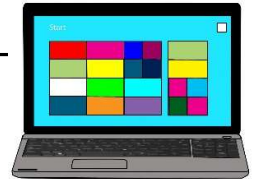
In P.E we are developing our throwing, catching, hitting, dribbling and kicking skills. We will invent our own games utilising these skills.
