


Year 1 - Autumn Term



In English we will be learning how to retell a story using a story map. We will be using our phonic knowledge to write words independently. We will focus on using a capital letter at the start of each sentence, finger spaces between each word and a full stop



In Maths we will be learning to count objects reliably, read number words, count on from a number, say 1 more, count back from a number and say 1 less. We will also learn about the greater than >, less than < and equal to = signs. We will then move onto parts and wholes linked to addition and subtraction, writing number sentences and fact families and recalling number bonds for numbers within and including 10.











In R.E we are learning about what Christians believe God is like, why Christmas is important to Christians and why Harvest is a worldwide celebration. We are looking forward to welcoming visitors from St John's Church in Windlesham to support us with some of our learning this term.







In History we are remembering things which have happened in our past to gain an understanding of the past. We then move on to thinking about symbols for remembering and in particular the poppy as a symbol of remembrance. After half-term we move on to the topic of transport, examining different forms of transport. We will look at how transport has changed over time, and begin to develop a





In PSHE we are learning about families and friendships, answering questions such as what is a family and what is a healthy friendship? We will also look at dealing with friendship problems, working together and recognising other people's emotions. After half-term we will be focusing on our own health and wellbeing. We will look at understanding our own emotions, the importance of sleep and relaxation as well as personal hygiene. Finally, we discuss allergies and the people who help to keep us





In P.E we are developing our ball skills through throwing, catching, dribbling, kicking and hitting. After half-term we will be focusing on dance as a topic where we will be linking our movements to the speed of different pieces of music and sequencing





In Science we are learning about seasonal changes with a focus on Autumn/Winter, including weather patterns, animal hibernation and the life cycles of different plants. After half-term we will be moving onto the topic of materials, naming and describing





In Music we will be listening to a variety of 'under the sea' songs to allow us to discuss the musical terms: pulse, tempo, dynamics, timbre, pitch, rhythm, texture and structure. After half-term we focus on pulse and rhythm through the topic 'all about



In Computing we are learning how to use a tablet independently, including logging on and off, saving our learning and staying safe when we are online. We will also use algorithms to create simple codes. After half-term we will be looking at grouping and sorting items by different criteria using the computer programme Purple Mash.



In Art we are exploring different types of lines including wavy lines. We will be creating individual and group pieces of art. We will be experimenting with different types of media including water colours, pens, chalks, pastels, crayons and colouring pencils. At the end of the unit we will apply our drawing skills and knowledge from the previous lessons to create an observational drawing piece. After half-term we will look at colour mixing, naming primary colours and learning how to mix primary colours to
