I know the UK is made up of four countries; England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland.



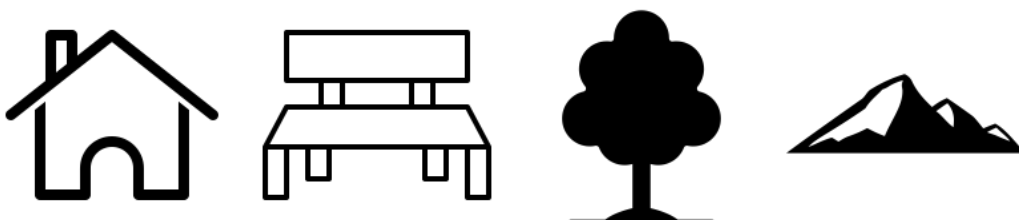
I can name some of the capital cities of the countries in the UK; London, Edinburgh, Cardiff and Belfast.
