

Year 1 - Monarchs

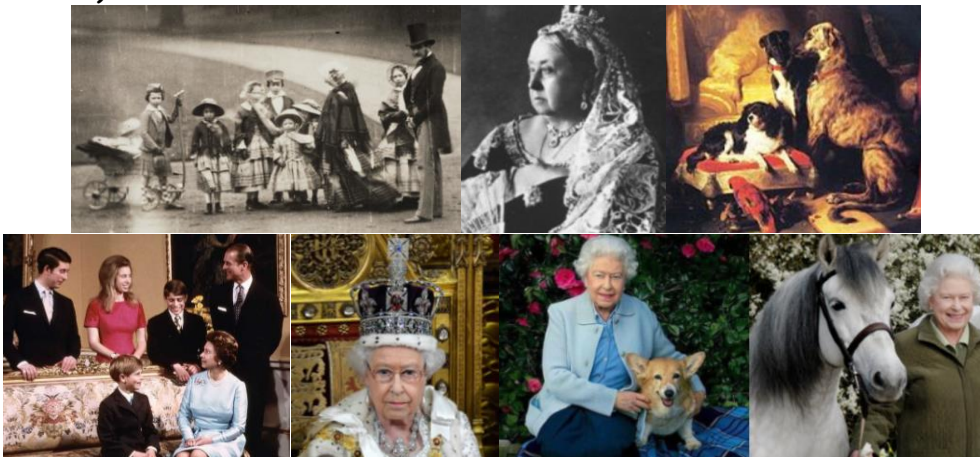

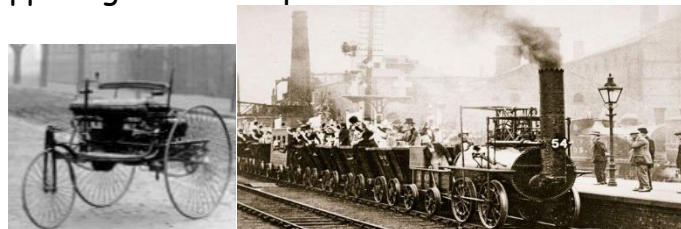
I can order three monarchs from past to present to future. I know what "next in line to the throne" means.
