Corefulness programme – permission for your child to participate in trial

Earlier this week you will have received a form to complete (via ParentMail) regarding a programme we use in school called Corefulness. The programme plays a crucial role in enhancing your child's fine and gross motor skills, balance, and coordination. These movement skills can significantly contribute to improved cognitive skills, aiding in areas such as reading, writing, and mathematics.

As part of our ongoing effort to evaluate, enhance and support the effectiveness of programmes implemented in our school, we have arranged for the Founder of Corefulness, Chartered Physiotherapist, Elizabeth Cordle to visit on April 25th to run a trial.

In April, Elizabeth will individually assess each child's ability to perform three simple movement patterns, as well as activities such as running, jumping, hopping, catching, throwing, balancing, and kicking a football.

To gauge the impact of the Corefulness programme, children will then be reassessed using the same activities at the conclusion of the summer term. These assessments aim to monitor the positive effects of the programme on your child's overall development. It is important to note that all children will continue participating in the Corefulness programme throughout this trial period.

All children participating in the trial will remain anonymous, and the trial results will be shared with Windlesham Village Infant School.

To include your child in this trial, we kindly ask you to complete the PMX consent form by Friday 19th April at the latest.

We appreciate your cooperation and look forward to the potential benefits this trial may bring to the development of our pupils.
