Absence reporting

We would like to remind you that if your child is going to be absent from school, this must be reported by the parent/carer before 9am on the day in question. Absences can be reported by telephone: 01276 472212, email: school@wvi.tamat.org.uk, or using the absence reporting function on ParentMail. Medical appointments that mean your child will be absent for part of the school day should also be reported this way.

We are aware that some absences may be communicated directly to a member of staff on the gate. Whilst this is absolutely fine, we ask that you still follow up with a message to the school office as it is not always possible for the member of staff to relay this to the office team straight away.

Absences should be reported for each day that your child is off school.

Please also remember that if your child has vomited or had diarrhoea they should not return to school until they have been clear for 48 hours from the last instance.
