We are unable to share the outcome of the inspection with you at this point; the provisional judgements have to go through moderation, quality assurance and fact-checking before the draft report is shared with the school and then finalised by the inspectorate.

What I can share is that we all felt the inspectors were respectful, empathetic and knowledgeable. They recognised that staff have multiple responsibilities in a small school. They thanked us for our flexibility and found our children to be delightful. We feel that the inspection was rigorous and fair.
