

In Science we are learning about seasonal changes with a focus on Autumn/Winter, including weather patterns, animal hibernation and the life cycles of different plants. After half-term we will be moving onto the topic of materials, naming and describing their properties.



In History we are learning about the Great Fire of London and life in 1666. We will find out:

- How the fire started and why it spread so quickly;
- Important people at the time including King Charles II;
- Lessons learnt from the fire.

After half-term we will be moving onto 'Foods and Festivals', starting with a 1666 cake. We will also learn about Harvest Festival and Christmas, and the importance of different foods during these times.



In Art & DT we are learning different techniques for creating animal pictures. We will investigate wheels and axles to create fire engines. After half-term we will be learning about portrait artists and investigating structures linking with Science and our knowledge of materials.



In P.E we are developing our ball skills through throwing, catching, dribbling, kicking and hitting. After half-term we will be learning about traditional English country dancing.



Key Stage 1 - Autumn Term

In Computing we are learning how to use a tablet independently, including logging on and off, saving our learning and staying safe when we are online. We will also use algorithms to create simple codes.



In R.E we are learning about what Christians think God is like, why Christmas is important to Christians and why Harvest is a worldwide celebration.



In PSHE we are learning about what makes us special and what is the same and different about us. We will learn how to keep ourselves safe using the NSPCC PANTS rule. After half-term we will be learning about who is special to us, including our families and other groups we belong to.



In Music we are learning about different genres of music, including Jazz and Pop. After half-term we will use instruments to show our understanding of dynamics, pitch, tempo, pulse and rhythm.
