- When using capital letters they are used appropriately.
- To use a full stop at the end of each sentence.
- To use a capital letter when writing their name.
- To use a capital letter for the pronoun I
- To know what a question mark is.
- To understand the terms plural, singular, noun and verb

Spelling

- Can spell some of the Y1 Common Exception Words
- Can segment spoken words and represent phonemes using the correct grapheme in some instances and phonetically plausible attempts in others.
- Adds s to some words to create plurals

Handwriting

- To form most of their letters accurately (capitals and lower case).
- Most letters are on the line.
- To use spaces between words.

Composition

- Reads aloud own writing.
- Write a simple sentence that makes sense.
- Can sequence sentences to form a short narrative (real or fictional).

Other requirements:

- Understands the school marking policy for writing.
- Writes from left to right/top to bottom.
- Puts 1 line through their learning if they make a mistake.
