

## Windlesham Village Infant School; COVID-19 Home-School Agreement

School	Parent/Carer	Pupil
<p><b>The school will:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>*Provide an environment which has been risk-assessed in response to the COVID-19 infection</li> <li>*Adhere to the social distancing rules as set out by the government as much as we reasonably can</li> <li>*Provide an education that meets the needs of your child’s well-being, mental health and academic needs</li> <li>*Contact parents/carers if your child displays symptoms of COVID-19</li> <li>*Inform you if staff or other children in your child’s bubble show symptoms of COVID-19; the bubble will be sent home to self-isolate. If the individual tests negative, the bubble will resume</li> <li>*We will follow the revised Behaviour Policy as well as the expectations outlined in this agreement</li> <li>*Communicate between home and school through Parentmail and the school website.</li> </ul>	<p><b>To help my child at school, I know and understand that:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>*If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school; we will self-isolate for 14 days as a family; I will get them tested and I will let the school know as soon as possible via telephone or email</li> <li>*If my child shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I will collect my child from school immediately when notified</li> <li>*On my commute, and when dropping my child off and picking them up, I will adhere to the 2 metre social distancing rules</li> <li>*When dropping off and picking up, I will strictly stick to the school timings for my child</li> <li>*My child will have their temperature taken during the day if they feel or present as being unwell.</li> <li>*I will need to remind my child about social distancing rules but accept they are difficult to follow and that my child may not always do this successfully</li> <li>*My child will need to use good respiratory hygiene</li> <li>*I will not be allowed into the school without a pre-arranged appointment. Communication with staff will be done via telephone or email</li> <li>*I need to support all staff in their efforts to create a safe environment during this crisis</li> <li>*I will wash my child’s clothes, lunchbox and drink bottle every day, where practical</li> <li>*I will read all Parentmail messages that are sent via email</li> <li>*I need to inform the school immediately of any changes to our emergency contacts’ details before my child returns to school</li> <li>*If my child’s behaviour is deemed unsafe, he/she will be sent home and cannot return to school until they can be safe (agreed by the Headteacher)</li> </ul>	<p><b>I will:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>*Follow the social distancing rules in class and in the playground</li> <li>*Tell an adult if I feel unwell</li> <li>*Not use anyone else’s equipment or stationery</li> <li>*Not mix with any other children in the school, other than in my ‘bubble’</li> <li>*Only enter and exit the school building using the correct gate/door</li> <li>*Follow good respiratory hygiene: coughing and sneezing into my elbow or a tissue (catch it, bin it, kill it)</li> <li>*Follow good hand hygiene-use soap and water for 20 seconds/hand sanitiser</li> <li>*Behave well at all times to maintain the safety of myself and others (following amended behaviour policy and rules set out by all staff)</li> <li>*Follow these expectations and know that if I don’t, I will be sent home and will not be able to come back into school until I can be safe</li> </ul>
